

JUDGES 72nd Championship Show Chantal Delafontaine (Belgium)



In 1988 we bought our first ADRK Leistungszucht bitch "Mona vom Eisplatz", in 1989 "Olga vom Eisplatz" and in 1990 "Peggi vom Eisplatz". With all these dogs we did social obedience, tracking and Schutz.

We started to breed in 1989 under the kennel name "Du Dauchant" Da: Damien (our son), Au: Aure (our daughter) Chant: Chantal .

Our first aim was to breed a family dog with very good character, willing to work and of course according to the breeding standard. We always took males from very good German bloodlines.

We got the owners of our puppies involved in showing and working with their dogs. We therefore created a K9club at home.

In order to offer a good service I followed the training courses at the St Hubertus to become an obedience and tracking instructor.

I passed the exams as an obedience instructor and also as an IPO instructor. We organised some obedience competition, IPO and even a Club Show.

I also followed the Ethology course at University of Namur and after being several times assistant to International Judges; I passed my theoretical exam in June 2001, in 2003 my practical exam and after having jugged the Brussels Dog Show, I was qualified as International judge in 2005.





JUDGES

33rd National Conformation Show & Breed Survey Pablo Piazza (Argentina)

I was born on August 16, 1971, in the city of Rosario, province of Santa Fe, Argentine Republic.

My main activity is related to commerce; and together with my family we are dedicated as a secondary activity to the breeding of Rottweiler, and it is our goal to achieve dogs of the highest level in terms of typicality, predisposition to work and with a balanced temperament, getting as close as possible to the breed standard.

I have been an exhibitor since 1989 and breeder of the Rottweiler breed since 1997. Obtained multiple National and International championships, ACRR ranking winners, specimens with approved work exams, best ACRR breeder 2008 and 2010, America's Cup winner, Sieger ACRR, Klubiseger ACRR. Owner of Moe's Rottweilers kennel founded in 1997. www.moesrottweilers.com

As a breeder together with my colleague and friend Gonzalo Torraga (Criadero Torracan) we introduced to my country imported litters from crosses with Akino Von der Lauterbrücke, Dux Von der Königskanzel, Muck Von der Scherau, Orlando Vom Hause Neubrand, Uwe Aus der Wildnis, and Lenz Von der Hassberghöhen among others to contribute to the improvement and growth of the Rottweiler breed, and in the same way I was incorporating into my team direct sons and daughters of dogs such as: Rick Von Burgthann, Akino Von der Lauterbrücke, Muck Von der Scherau, Jumbo Vom Kümelsse, Mambo Von der Crossener Ranch, Exel Vom Weissen Schwan, Rex Von der Bleichstrasse, Lenz Von der Hassberghohen, Medoc Von der Maulbeergraben, Reni Vom Hause Neubrand, Adina Vom Kreesbach, Elvis Von der Mühlbachstrasse, Lennox Vom



I have been President of the Association of Rottweiler Breeders of Argentina 2010/2012, member of the Rosario Can Club Board of Directors for several periods and current Life Member, partner and member of the Board of Directors of the Association of Rottweiler Breeders of Argentina for several periods.

I worked actively since 1990 along with other breeders and exhibitors organizing specialised open exhibitions, and for the formation and founding of the Argentine Rottweiler Club, which later led to the current ACRR.

I have attended various Rottweiler breed seminars given by Rottweiler breed specialist judges (Mr. Pedro Pujals Prat, Dr. Carla Lensi, Mr. Edgar Hellmann, Mr. Dirk Vandecasteele, Mr. Dieter Hoffmann, Mr. Frank Hedtke, Mr. Helmut Weiler), as well as Cynology Course, basis for future judges, taught at the Argentine Cynological Federation in 2007 and many courses including "Genetic Selection for Breeders" course and the "Applied Biomechanics in Canines (Movement)" course taught by the veterinary doctor Dr. Ricardo Ravaglia at the headquarters of the Circle of Biomedical Sciences of the city of Rosario in 2009.

My love for dog training began in 1982 with my Weimaraner Jessie.

I started trialling with my Dalmatians Rommy and Rebel, and in 2005 Rommy and I achieved our Australian Obedience Champion Title.

Open to Dogs & Bitches 18 months and over

**All Owners must be a member of one of the NRC(A) clubs to participate **

Points awarded only for RCV shows & RCSA shows in the one calendar year

- 6 Points for 1st Place (input points for 1st place 6)
- 5 Points for 2nd Place (input points for 2nd place 5)
- 4 Points for 3rd Place (input points for 3rd place 4)
- 3 Points for 4th Place (input points for 4th place 3)
- 2 Points for 5th Place (input points for 5th place 2)
- 1 Point for 6th Place (input points for 6th place 1)

BREED SURVEY

Monday 3rd November, 2025 - Lloyd Park, Belgrave South 8.00am check in, NRC(A) Breed Survey Commences 8.30am

THE SURVEY

A. CLASSIFICATIONS

Pass - Suitable For Breeding

(Allocated to all dogs that pass all areas of the breed survey). A dog that receives a pass rating is not permitted to present at future breed surveys. Where this has occurred in the past, it is only the first result that is recognised.

Fail - Not Suitable For Breeding

(Allocated to dogs that possess a breed disqualifying fault or are assessed as having an unacceptable temperament). A dog that receives a fail rating is not permitted to be represented at future Breed Surveys.

Re-present - Dogs may re-present on 2 occasions (Allocated to those dogs that are eligible for representing). A dog that cannot complete the breed survey following the 2 represents is deemed to have failed the breed survey

B. ANATOMICAL CONSTRUCTION

- 1. Each dog is to be presented individually and positively identified via microchip.
- 2. The dog will then be weighed, measured, eye color assessed, teeth and bite examined. The results are to be immediately transcribed onto the survey form by the officiating surveyor.
- 3. The officiating surveyor will then complete a written critique on the general appearance, attitude, constitution, conformation, movement, and fitness levels of the dog.
- 4. Double handling will be permitted; however, the surveyor may stop the practice if in their opinion, the practice is hazardous or unruly. One handler only allowed for Critique but substitute handler may be used for running.

The Survey process shall not be split.

C. CHARACTER & TEMPERAMENT ASSESSMENT

a. The Gun Test (Reaction to loud and sudden noises)

Each dog is brought into the assessment area individually wherein the handler will be asked to heel their dog on a loose lead.

The surveyor/steward will fire two (2) shots in succession at a distance of not less than ten (10) meters from the dog. The dog is allowed to be startled by the noise but must quickly recover and must continue heeling with the handler. The dog is not allowed to show signs of fear or nervousness. The surveyor may if deemed necessary, request that more shots be fired.

The dog's reaction to the sudden noise is to be documented on the survey form by the surveyor.

b. The Crowd Test

The dog and handler are to proceed through the crowd (10-12 persons) which is milling about and then both the handler and dog are to stop in the middle of the crowd at which time the dog is instructed to sit. The crowd will then form a large circle around the dog and handler, then move in on the handler and dog at a normal pace and completely surround them.

Upon instruction from the surveyor, the crowd will move away from the dog and handler. A further request will be made by the surveyor for the crowd to move in and surround both the dog and handler a second time at a fast pace.

Finally, the surveyor will instruct the crowd to move away from the dog and handler who will then heel away from the crowd.

The dog shall not show signs of aggression or nervousness. Natural curiosity, sniffing etc, is permitted. The surveyor will document the dog's reaction to this pressure situation on the survey form.

If a dog shows/presents any unprovoked aggression towards any person or persons or attempts to, or bites any person, the dog will automatically receive a **fail** rating and will take no further part in the breed survey.

Note: This is applicable at any time throughout the Breed Survey test.

c. Character & Temperament Assessment

At the completion of the crowd exercise, the handler will walk with his dog to a pre- determined spot approx twenty (20) meters from a hiding place. The handler will be required to remain stationary and allow the dog freedom of movement to the extent of the lead.

On the surveyor's signal, a helper will emerge and challenge the handler. After allowing reaction time for the dog, the helper will run diagonally across and stop in a position approx fifteen (15) meters away and challenge the handler a second time.

From this position the helper will run diagonally and stop approx ten (10) meters away and challenge again. The helper will then continue directly toward the handler and dog in a threatening manner to a distance of a minimum three to five (3-5) meters, or until the surveyor instructs the helper to stop the threat.

The dog must not attempt to flee or show signs of fear, nervousness or aggression.

The dog's reaction to this situation/ exercise is to be recorded on the survey form by the surveyor.


